Gives and bequeaths to **her son Edward** the sum of one pound a year for the term of his natural life to be paid to him by her Executor.

Gives and bequeaths to her daughter Ann the sum of twenty pounds.

Gives and bequeaths to **her granddaughter Elizabeth Wynne** the sum of twenty pounds to be paid to her by her Executor once she reaches the age of twenty-one years or to her parents in case of her death before the said period.

All the rest and residue of her personal estate she gives and bequeaths to **her son Robert Pugh** whom she nominates, constitutes and appoints sole Executor of her last will and testament.
