All the rest and residue of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to **his wife Elizabeth** whom he also constitutes, nominates and ordains Sole Executrix of his last will and testament, observing that if his said wife Elizabeth should marry again, then his will is that she is to be excluded of and from every benefit of and from his last will and testament, except for a bedstead, with bed and bedclothes. In that case he nominates, appoints and ordains his three younger children Edward, Robert and Ann to be Co-executors of this his last will and testament.
