Leaves and bequeaths to her eldest daughter Rebecca Owen the wife of John Owen the oak bureau now in her dwelling house but divested of all deeds, papers, writings or any other things it may contain at the time of her decease. She also leaves and bequeaths to the said Rebecca her large looking glass.

Leaves and bequeaths £65 to **her daughter Jane Humphreys** and also one of her milk cows.

Leaves and bequeaths £31 to her daughter Mary Humphreys.

Leaves and bequeaths £25 to her daughter Anne Williams.

Leaves and bequeaths £87 10s. to her daughter Elizabeth Parry.

All the rest and residue of her personal estate (should there be any) she leaves and bequeaths to **her daughters Mary, Sarah, Jane, Anne and Elizabeth**, share and share alike.

Nominates, constitutes and appoints Owen Humphrey Owen of Cefn y filldin?, farmer, and Humphrey Humphreys of Llanfair Hill, Gentleman, to be joint Executors of her last will and testament.
