Abstract of the Will of Ellis Jones of Ddolwen in the Parish of Trawsfynydd and County of Merioneth, Yeoman, written 2 Jun 1784, proved 22 Nov 1784.

Gives and bequeaths £60 in Trust to his son Robert Jones of Maes y Garnedd in the parish of Llanelltyd in the said county, yeoman, and to his friend John Jones of Blaen Lliw in the parish of Llanuwchllyn in the said county, yeoman, that they shall place the £60 out at interest and to pay the interest yearly to his daughter Margaret now the wife of Edmund Jones of Ysgwrn in Trawsfynydd, yeoman, for her sole and separate use for the term of her natural life, the £60 to be paid among any children lawfully begotten of his daughter Margaret Jones by the said Edmund Jones once they each attain the age of twenty-one years, share and share alike.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his daughter Ellin now the wife of Robert Lloyd of Cefn y Clawdd in Trawsfynydd.

All the rest and residue of his goods, cattle, chattels, effects and personal estate to **his wife Margaret Jones** and his son Robert Jones whom he nominates, constitutes and appoints co-Executors of his last will and testament.

Wills and desires that his wife Margaret Jones shall have all his household furniture.
