Gives and bequeaths 25 shillings a year out of Rhwng y D---bont [and] ----nant to **Robert Morrice and Margaret Wynne his wife** during their natural lives.

Gives and bequeaths a press cupboard to his sister Catherine Wynne.

Gives and bequeaths to his cousin Jonett v^{ch} Robert the daughter of Robert Morice and Margaret Wynne a chest he bought from Owen Jones.

Gives and bequeaths to his mother his morning gown that he now wears.

Gives and bequeaths three pounds to his uncle John Wynne.

Gives and bequeaths three pounds to his uncle David Wynne.

Gives and bequeaths one pound to his aunt Anne Wynne.

Gives and bequeaths 40 shillings to Margaret Lloyd.

Constitutes, ordains and appoints his said brother William Wynne sole executor of his last will and testament.
