Abstract of the Will of John Jones of Ynyscain in the Parish of Criccieth in the County of Caernarvon, Gentleman, written 7 Mar 1787, proved 26 Apr 1787.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to his eldest son Robert Jones.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to his eldest daughter Elizabeth now the wife of John Owen of Crafnant in the County of Merioneth.

Gives and bequeaths £60 each to his six younger children Maurice, John, Catherine, Anne, Jonnet and Lowry Jones, to be paid to them when they attain the age of twenty-one years or are married with the consent of his Executrix.

Refers to a sum of £300 with a large arrear of interest owing to him by virtue of a Bond dated 15 Nov 1755 under the seal of William Wynne late of Wern in county Carnarvon, Esquire, long since deceased; and another amount of £100 with a large arrear of interest owing to him by virtue of a Note dated 23 Jan 1761 under the seal of the said William Wynne deceased, which sums with their interest he gives and bequeaths to his Executrix, namely **his wife Lowry Jones**, in Trust, for his six younger children.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate and effects he gives and bequeaths to his said wife Lowry, appointing her sole Executrix of his last will and testament.
