*Abstract of the Will of John Lewis of Rhiw in the County of Caernarvon, Gentleman, written 10 Dec 1719, proved 28 May 1729.*

Refers to an Indenture quadripartite dated 28 Mar 1718 between himself John Lewis and **Maurice Lewis of Methlam his heir apparent** in the first part, Henry Eliot of the town of Carnarvon, Gent. and William Prichard of Berth Llwyd, Gent. of the second part, Humphrey Meredith of Pengwern, Gent. and Robert Lloyd of Brynkir, Gent. of the third part, and Griffith Roberts of Rhiw goch, Gent. of the fourth part, wherein is contained a proviso in which he has a power reserved to charge all and any part of his messuages, hereditaments & premises named in the Indenture to a value not exceeding £55 to be paid to his executrix, **his daughter Mary Lewis**. . . . .

. . . . . **his son-in-law Rev<sup>d</sup>. Robert Wynne**, Rector of Llan. . . . . now husband of **his daughter Anne Lewis** the sum of £5.

. . . . . **his sister-in-law Sarah Griffith**. . . . .

On 8 Apr 1729 an inventory of the goods and chattels of John Lewis of Rhiw in the County of Carnarvon, Gent, deceased, was taken by Evan Griffith and William Lewis and valued to £74 16s.
