Abstract of the Will of Jonett Wynne of Argoed in the Parish of Llanfair-juxta-Harlech in the County of Merioneth, Widow, written 2 Oct [1710], proved 6 Dec 1710.

Gives and bequeaths to **her daughter Margarett** all her wearing apparel and one moiety or part of all her household stuff and effects.

Gives and bequeaths £6 to her said daughter Margarett.

Gives 1 shilling to her son Griffith Rowland.

Gives half a crown each to the rest of her children.

All the rest & residue of her personal estate she gives and bequeaths to **her sons John Rowland and William Rowland**, desiring them to pay her debts which are as far as she can remember £3 to **her son-in-law Samuel Poole** and 30 pence to one Lowry ---?---.

Nominates and appoints her said sons John Rowland and William Rowland as joint executors of her last will and testament.
