Abstract of the Will of Joseph Hunt of Poole in the County of Dorset, Carpenter & Sawyer, written 30 Aug 1833, proved 1 Jul 1836.

Gives £140 to his brother Jonas Hunt.

Gives £120 to his brother Jesse Hunt.

Gives £100 to his brother John Hunt.

Gives £100 to his sister Patience Taylor (wife of William Taylor of Hillmarton in the county of Wilts, victualler).

Gives £20 to his nephew Abel Neale (son of his late sister Mary Neale, deceased).

Gives £20 to his niece Mary Neale (daughter of his said sister Mary Neale, deceased).

All the rest and residue of his estate and effects he gives and bequeaths among his aforesaid brothers Jonas Hunt, Jesse Hunt, John Hunt, his said sister Patience Taylor, his said nephew Abel Neale and his said niece Mary Neale.

Gives and bequeaths to his nephew Joseph Hunt (son of his said brother Jesse Hunt) his set of hand bells fixed in a frame.

Nominates, constitutes and appoints his said brothers Jonas Hunt and Jesse Hunt co-executors of his last will.

Joseph son of Joseph & Hester Hunt of Hillmarton was buried in Hilmarton on 6 Jan 1836, aged 58 years (b.c. 1778). Joseph Hunt was christened in Hilmarton on 31 Oct 1777, son of Joseph & Hetty Hunt.

Joseph Hunt was bequeathed £50 in his mother's Will (1826).s
