Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Richards of the Parish of Gwinear in the County of Cornwall, written 11 Nov 1697, proved 24 Apr 1699.

Gives £5 to **his son Christopher Richards**, to be paid when he is married or turns twenty-one.

Gives £5 to **his daughter Mary Richards**, to be paid to her when she turns twenty-one.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his wife Mary**.

Gives to **his son Nicholas Richards** his tenement of Tregotha.

Appoints **his wife Mary Richards** sole executrix of his last will and testament.

An inventory of the goods, chattels & credits of Nicholas Richards late of the parish of Gwinear, was taken & appraised on 3 Feb 1698/9 by John Elles and Christopher Richards and valued to £19 12s.
