Devises and bequeaths one moiety of a tenement called Cae maen llwŷd in the Parish of Caerhun in the County of Carnarvon to **his eldest son Thomas**Smallwood and his heirs.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to his wife Jonett, nominating and appointing her sole Executrix of his last will and testament. Signed
