The Will of Christian Baath of Wootton Bassett, written 10 Mar 1635/6, proved 11 Mar 1636/7.

IN THE NAME OF GOD Amen, this tenth day of March in the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred thirtie and five, I Christian Baath of Wotten Bassett beinge weake in bodie but of a perfecte remembrance doe make and ordaine this my last will and testament in manner and forme followinge.

First I committ my Soule unto Allmightie god my maker and Redeemer and my bodie unto the ground from whence it was taken. Nowe for the settlinge of my worldly estate which it hath pleased god to endue me withall:

Imprimis I give to the Cathedrall church of Sarum twelve pence.

Item. I give unto my sister Edith Horsell tenn poundes.

Item. I give unto **Anne Horsell** twenty nobles.

Item. I give unto **Christian Horsell** twenty nobles.

Item. I give best Coverlett unto **my sister Edith Horsell** and after her decease my Will is that **her daughter Anne Horsell** shall have him.

Item. I give unto **Anne Horsell** my greate brasse pott.

Item. I give unto **Christian Horsell** my greate brasse pann and a little Kettle and a skillett and one paire of my best fine sheets.

Item. I give unto my brother Robert Baath twelve pence.

Item. I give unto **Christian Horsell** all my lynnen and the Chest wherein it lyeth and my best petticoate.

Item. I give unto Anne Horsell the Chest in the lofte.

For all my other goodes and chattells whatsoever moveable and unmoveable I give and bequeath unto **Bartholomew Horsell** and I make him my sole and full executor of this my last Will and testament.

Item. I give unto **Anne Horsell** my greate Cowle and one fether pillowe and alsoe I give one fether pillowe unto **Christian Horsell**.

I doe desire my lovinge friends **Master John Say** now Maior and **Richard Curtis Senior** to be Overseers of this my last Will and testament and I give unto them twoe shillings apeece to be paied unto them within fourteteene daies after my decease.

Signed CHRISTIAN BAATH. Sealed and delivered in the presence of Thomas Floyde, Anne Horsell.

Christian BAATH (BATH) was buried in Wootton Bassett on 3 Jun 1636.
