Gives and bequeaths a legacy of 20 shillings to his son Robert Lloyd.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to his reputed son Ellis Thomas.

Gives and devises his messuage, lands and tenements in Llandanocke in county Merioneth called Hendre Dydd to **his son-in-law Lewis Lloyd, Gent.**, as well as £9 he owes him, and also a legacy of £11.

Gives and devises his messuage, lands and tenements in Llanvair in county Merioneth called Tythyn stockyn y weirglodd fawr to **his wife Elizabeth Lloyd** and **his son Owen Lloyd**.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to his said wife Elizabeth Lloyd and son Owen Lloyd, making them executors of his last will and testament.
