Fletcher the husband of the said Joyce Fletcher to hold the same upon trust for Nancye Fletcher the daughter of the said Joyce Fletcher until she shall attain the age of eighteen years to pay from the income thereof such amounts as he in his absolute discretion shall deem necessary for the maintenance education and advancement of the said Nancye Fletcher with power to sell call in and convert such part of the corpus as he in his absolute discretion shall deem necessary for the maintenance education and advancement of the said Nancye Fletcher.
