Will of John Newick, late of Peak Hill, Station Hand, written 15 May 1930, probate 18 Aug 1932.

I John Newick at present residing at near Peak Hill in the State of New South Wales, Station Hand, hereby revoke all wills codicils and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last will. 1. I leave devise and bequeath all my property of whatsoever nature kind or description and wheresoever situate of or to which I shall die seised possessed of or entitled to unto **my nephew John Ross** son of my brother in law Thomas [sic] Ross and I appoint the said John Ross sole executor of this my will. In Witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name this fifteenth day of May one thousand nine hundred and thirty. John Newick.
