This is the last will and Testament of me Kingsley O'Donnell formerly of Emmaville but now of the Australian Imperial Forces whereof I appoint **my brother Frank Arthur Leslie O'Donnell** of Glen Innes Solicitor Sole Executor. I give devise and bequeath the whole of my estate both real and personal of or to which I shall die possessed or entitled unto **my wife Sylvia O'Donnell** absolutely. I direct payment of my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses and lastly I revoke all former wills. As witness my hand this 31st day of January one thousand nine hundred and seventeen. Kingsley O'Donnell.
