*Will of Maurice John O'Donnell late of Emmaville - Storekeeper, written 16 Jan 1899, Admon 16 Feb 1934.*

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me MAURICE JOHN O'DONNELL of Emmaville in the Colony of New South Wales. AFTER payment of all my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses I GIVE DEVISE and BEQUEATH unto my Wife MARGARET O'DONNELL all my worldly possessions and I HEREBY APPOINT DANIEL MAURICE O'DONNELL of Emmaville EXECUTOR of this my Will. IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 16th (sixteenth) day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety nine. MAURICE JOHN O'DONNELL.

SIGNED by the said M.J. O'DONNELL the Testator and by him declared to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us present at the same time who in their presence at his request and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses: EUGENE DUDLEY O'DONNELL — W.A. REED.

16th February, 1934 — On this date Letters of Administration (with the Will annexed) of the said deceased were granted to MARGARET O'DONNELL of Emmaville - the Widow of the said deceased, the sole beneficiary named in the said will - the executor therein having predeceased.
