

New South Wales Will Books, 1800-1952, no. 12820.

Will of John Shaw late of Mudgee, freeholder, written 23 Nov 1896, proved 18 Feb 1897.

This is the last Will and Testament of John Shaw of Denison Street Mudgee in the Colony of New South Wales. I John Shaw hereby revoke any and all previous Wills made by me. I direct that my house and its belongings together with such revenue as may be derived from the said property in Denison Street Mudgee shall be the property of **my wife Janet Shaw** during her lifetime. And I further direct that the said property in Denison Street Mudgee be given to **my son William** on the decease of my wife subject to the payment by **my son William** of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds (£150) to **my daughter Janet Cassimer**. I hereby appoint **my son William** and **Charles Cassimer my son in law** Executors of this my last Will.

Signed in our presence and in the presence of each at Denison Street Mudgee on this the twenty third day of November 1896.

18th February 1897. By Act of Court. Probate of the last Will and Testament of the abovenamed deceased granted to William Shaw of Mudgee, newspaper proprietor, and Charles Casimir of Mudgee, bricklayer, the Executors in Will named.
