Abstract of the Will of Abraham Banbury of the Parish of Launcells in the County of Cornwall, written 12 Jul 1693, proved 7 Feb 1700.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his daughter lzet**, along with his second best bed, some pewter dishes, his second-best brass pan and his second-best brass pot.

All the rest of his goods he gives to his son Thomas Banbury.

Wills that **his wife Alice** shall have the use of half of all his goods toward her ongoing maintenance as long as she lives.

Appoints **his son Thomas Banbury** as sole executor of his last will and testament. (his mark)
