

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/B/1840 W, Inv.

Abstract of the Will of Bartholomew Banfield of the Parish of Redruth in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 16 May 1676, proved 14 May 1678.

Gives to **his son Thomas** half his right and interest in a pair of stamping mills which join the testator's tenement of Trereufe, along with half of his tin bounds in the parishes of Redruth and Gwennap.

Gives 20 shillings to **his daughter Margret the wife of Thomas Martyn**.

Gives 5 shillings each to **his grandchildren John Martyn, Margery Martyn, Jone Martyn and Thomas Martyn**, children of the said Thomas Martyn.

Gives 5 shillings each to **his grandchildren Bartholomew Banfield and Margery Banfield**.

All the rest of his goods and chattels, houses, leases, lands and tenements, he gives to **his son Stephen Banfield** and his heirs, conditional on him paying an annuity of £12 to his mother the testator's wife, **Margery Banfield**, for the term of her natural life.

Gives **his wife Margery** 40 shillings.
