

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/B/4125 W.

Abstract of the Will of Alexander Barret of the Parish of Gwennap in the County of Cornwall, Tinner, written 12 Jan 1762, proved 10 May 1762.

Gives an annuity of £3 to his wife (not named) for life.

Gives to **his daughter Catharine Barret** an annuity of £3.

Gives £3 to **his son Hercules Barret**.

Gives £7 to **his daughter Eleanor the wife of Richard Richard**.

Gives to **his daughter Mary the wife of Houghton Vivian** an annuity of £1 for life.

Desires that his wife and daughter Catharine live in the house where he now dwells.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his sons John and Alexander**, whom he appoints co-executors of his last will and testament.
