Abstract of Administration.

Martha Bennats of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, widow, William Tyack of the same place, blacksmith, and Edward Jackson of Penryn, yeoman, paid a bond of £12 for Administration of the goods, chattels and credits of Richard Bennats late of Camborne aforesaid intestate.

An inventory of the goods of Richard Bennetts of the parish of Camborne lately deceased was taken on 4 Jan 1751 by Richard Williams and Thomas Martin and valued at £4 4s.

Inventory and bond upon the Administration of the goods &c. of one Richard Bennatts lately intestate deceased was granted 7 May 1751 to **Martha Bennatts, the widow** and relict of the said deceased.
