Abstract of the Will of Nicholas Blewett of Trelissick in the Parish of St. Erth and County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 23 Feb 1813, proved 14 May 1817.

Gives to **his wife Elizabeth** an annuity of £33, a bed, six chairs, tables and other furniture for one room during her widowhood. After her death or remarriage he gives the latter articles to **his son William Lemon Blewett**.

Gives to **his son William Lemon Blewett** the whole of his property. If William should die without children, then he wills his property to **his brothers John Blewett** of the island of Scilly **and Hannibal Curnow Blewett** of Marazion, share and share alike.

Appoints **his brother Hannibal Curnow Blewett** and William Busustow the Senior of Trevethow in the parish Lelant co-executors of his last will and testament.
