

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/228/213.

Abstract of the Will of Walter Burlace of the Parish of Paul in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 19 Oct 1646, proved 25 Jun 1653.

Gives £5 toward reparation of the parish church of Paul.

Gives £5 to the poor of Paul.

Gives £5 to **his sister Mary Paynter**, widow.

Gives to **his sister Dorothy Keigwin** all the rent **her late husband John Keigwin** owed.

Gives £5 to **his nephew Nicholas Hickes**.

Gives £60 to **his nephew John Hickes**.

Givses £20 to **his sister Philippe Gwavas**, widow, which she owes him by bond.

Gives £3 to **his niece Jane Keigwin now the wife of William Bosen**.

Gives £20 to **his nephew William Hickes**.

Gives 20 shillings each to **his nephews Peter Paynter and Thomas Paynter**.

Gives 2 shillings each to his godchildren.

Gives 20 shillings to Jane Hugh.

Gives 5 shillings to Christopher Hugh.

Gives to his other servants 5 shillings each.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his brother John Burlace**, whom he appoints sole executor of his will.
