Abstract of the Will of Thomas Butson of the Parish of St. Agnes in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 18 Feb 1847, proved 8 Jul 1847. [2](#)

Gives and bequeaths 4 shillings a week to his wife for the rest of her life, to be paid out of the Goonown estate. Also gives to her all his household furniture and a dwelling house currently occupied by Henry Ely.

Gives and bequeaths to **his daughter Jane** his two closes of a field called the Ten Acres or Lower Croft, along with one half of his mineral rights in the Goonown estate.

All the rest of his lands, goods, chattels and effects he gives and bequeaths to **his son William** whom he makes sole executor of his last will.
