*Abstract of the Will of John Carpenter the Younger of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Miner, written 2 Apr 1833, proved 16 Sep 1833.*

Gives to **his four daughters Mary Ann Hill, Harriet Carpenter, Eliza Carpenter and Susanna Carpenter** his two leasehold rooms in the village of Highway (adjoining his father's) with the gardens belonging to them, immediately following the death of his wife Susannah Carpenter.

Gives to **his wife Susannah Carpenter** during her widowhood his leasehold tenements, dwelling houses, lands, household furniture, club monies and other effects, nominating her sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Gives and devises to **his sons John Carpenter and William Carpenter** his leasehold dwelling houses, lands, tenements and premises (except the two rooms and garden abovementioned), share and share alike, following the death or re-marriage of **his wife Susanna**.
