Gives an annuity of £4 to his wife during her widowhood so long as **William Garter** and **Ann his wife** shall live. He also gives her any his household goods for her use as well as a croft house to live in.... The same shall pass to William Garter's children at her decease.

All the rest and residue of his goods and chattels he gives to **his daughter Ann**, making her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
