Abstract of the Will of Margaret Cock of the Parish of Gwithian in the County of Cornwall, Widow, written 23 Jan 1782, proved 12 May 1790.

Gives to **her daughter Ann the wife of Samuel Johns** of the parish of Gwinear a guinea of gold and a gold ring.

Gives to **her son John Cock** a silver-brimmed fruit dish called the Mazzard dish.

Gives to **her daughter Margaret** all her household goods and wearing apparel.

Gives to **her son Bennett Cock** a large brass brewing pan.

All the rest of her effects, cash and accounts she gives to **her two sons John Cock and Bennett Cock**, and **her daughter Margaret Cock**, share and share alike, appointing them co-executors of her last will and testament.
