

Kresen Kernow (formerly Cornwall Record Office), Reference: AP/C/2116/1.

Abstract of the Will of Samuel Cory of the Parish of Launcells in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 17 Apr 1683, inventory taken 3 Mar 1690, proved 12 Nov 1690.

Gives to **his wife Merriam Cory** his tenement and all his dead goods for as long as she lives. And after her death he gives his tenement to **his son John Cory**.

Wills that **his daughter Jone Juell** be paid £3 by **his son John** within 6 months after his decease. He also bequeaths to **his daughter Jone Juell** 40 shillings.

Gives 12 pence to each of his grandchildren.

Gives to **his son John Cory** the tableboard in the hall and other household items.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his daughters Jane Cory and Charity Cory** whom he makes co-executrices of his last will and testament.
