Abstract of the Will of Samuel Cory of the Parish of Launcells in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 17 Apr 1683, inventory taken 3 Mar 1690, proved 12 Nov 1690.

Gives to **his wife Merriam Cory** his tenement and all his dead goods for as long as she lives. And after her death he gives his tenement to **his son John Cory**.

Wills that **his daughter Jone Juell** be paid £3 by **his son John** within 6 months after his decease. He also bequeaths to **his daughter Jone Juell** 40 shillings.

Gives 12 pence to each of his grandchildren.

Gives to his son John Cory the tableboard in the hall and other household items.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his daughters Jane**Cory and Charity Cory whom he makes co-executrices of his last will and
testament.
