

*Abstract of the Will of David Curnow of the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 18 Jan 1738/9, proved 24 May 1739.*

Gives to **his wife Jane** his right and interest in a tenement called Gwelcarne als. Chycarne, for the term of her natural life.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son David Curnow**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son William Curnow**.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son James Curnow**.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Katharine**.

Gives £10 to **his daughter Zenobia**.

All the rest of his goods & chattels, lands and tenements he gives to **his son John Curnow**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
