Gives £25 each to his grandson Henry Hannibal Curnow and his granddaughter Jone Mary Ann, children of his daughter Mary the wife of Mr. Henry Phillips of the borough of St. Ives, merchant.

Gives £300 to his daughter Mary the wife of the said Henry Phillips.

Gives £20 to his daughter Elizabeth Curnow, widow.

Gives 2 guineas each to his servants Thomas Richards, Margaret James and Elizabeth Giles.

Gives 1 guinea each to his boys William Branwell and William Giles.

Gives to **his grandson**, the said **Henry Hannibal Phillips**, his freehold estate in Bosigian? in the parish of Zennor.

All the rest of his freehold lands, tenements and hereditaments in the parishes of Ludgvan, Towednack and Madron he gives to **his daughter Ann Curnow**, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.
