

Abstract of the Will of Michael Curnow of the Parish of Towednack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 30 Apr 1716, proved 29 Aug 1718.

Gives 10 shillings to **his wife Margery**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Michael**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Jane**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his daughter Margery**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Jacob**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son Hannibal**.

Gives 5 shillings to **his son William**.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his brother Robert Curnow**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
