

*Abstract of Administration.*

William Curnow of Towednack, yeoman, died without making a will. An inventory of his goods & chattels was appraised by Andrew Stevens and James Woollcock of the same place on 26 Dec 1713. Sum-total: £107 0s. 8d.

On 14 Jan 1713/4 **Mary Curnow\***, **widow** and relict of the deceased, renounced all right and interest in the Administration of his goods &c., turning it over to **Robert Curnow, Peter Curnow or Michael Curnow**, the principal creditors. Witnesses: John Grosse, Thomas Gendall, Richard Gendall

Administration was granted to **Michael Curnow, brother of the deceased**, on 18 Jan 1713/4.
