Gives 1 shilling to **her son-in-law Peter Willy**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Simon Lugg** as well as a cupboard, bed and bedding.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Joseph Lugg** as well as a cupboard, bed and bedding.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Thomas Lugg**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her granddaughter Sarah Lugg**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her granddaughter Grace Lyne**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her granddaughter Ann Lugg**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Joseph Dale**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Henry Dale**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her grandson Edward Dale**.

Gives 20 guineas to **her granddaughter Elizabeth Dale**.

Makes **her son Thomas Dale** sole executor of her last will and testament.
