Gives one shilling each to his sons Brian and John.

Gives one shilling each to his daughters Christian and Ann.

Gives **his daughter Elizabeth** his estate in Lower Pentire, paying to her brother John £6 per year.

Gives to **his sons Robert and Thomas** his estate in Chiverloe, his estate in Trelesken, his money, household goods and other effects, making them co-executors of his last will and testament.
