Abstract of the Will of William Daniell of the Parish of Camborne in the County of Cornwall, Gentleman, written 22 Sep 1733, proved 6 Feb 1734/5.

Gives to **his wife Wilmot Daniell** his leasehold estate, lands and tenements called Weeths situated near Church Town in Camborne, for the term of her natural life. After her death he bequeaths the same to **his son William Daniell**.

Also gives to **his wife Wilmot Daniell** two featherbeds and what other household goods she deems useful, along with one milk cow and a horse.

Gives to his son Thomas Daniell his leashold lands and tenements called Crane and Gojegoe. After the decease of Thomas he wills the same to his son William and to **Edward Laurance** of the parish of Feock, merchant, and **William John** of the parish of Illogan, gentleman, in trust, for the benefit of Thomas's children, once they turn twenty-one.

Also gives to **his son Thomas Daniell** his right and title in the Rectory? or Glebe lands in Camborne, which he holds by lease from Mr. Robert Newsombe.

Gives one guinea each to the children of **Edward Lawrance and Welmot his wife**. He also gives a guinea each to the children of his son Thomas.

Gives to **his son William Daniell** his lands, tenements and hereditaments situated in the town fields & hamlets of Trewoone within the parish of Camborne.

Appoints his son William Daniell sole executor of his last will and testament. (his sign)
