Gives £50 to his son Patrick, to be paid to him when he turns twenty-one.

Gives £20 to his son David.

Gives £5 to his grandson David.

Gives 1 shilling to **Catherine the wife of Tho: Maddren**.

Gives 1 shilling to **Anne the wife of Nicholas Christophers**.

Gives to **his son Phillip** the estate of Fe----- in the village of Bosiggran in Zennor.

All the rest of his goods, lands and chattels he gives to **his sons Phillip and Richard Eddy**, appointing them co-executors of his last will and testament.
