Gives to **his son Peter Ellis** his estate and inheritance in fee in Sellan Vean in the parish of Sancreed, except the Grist Mills and the Little Carter.

Gives one guinea to his grandson Peter Ellis, son of his son Peter.

Gives to his son Pascoe Ellis his two Grist Mills and the Little Carter.

Gives to **his son Thomas Ellis** his leasehold and chattel estate in Great Sellan, of the inheritance of Walter Borlase, Doctor of Law.

Gives to his son **John Ellis** his leasehold and chattel estate in Great Sellan, of the inheritance of Humphry Mackworth Prade, Esq.

Gives 1 guinea to his kinsman Thomas Ellis.

Gives 1 shilling each to his son-in-law Richard Brokenshear and his daughter Eliz: Brokenshear.

Gives £20 to his son Francis Ellis.

Gives £20 to his son Charles Ellis.

Appoints his son Pascoe Ellis as sole executor of his last will and testament.
