Abstract of the Will of Peter Ellis of the Parish of Sancreed in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 4 Jan 1774, proved 12 May 1780.

Gives to **his son Peter Ellis** his estate and inheritance in fee in Sellan Vean in the parish of Sancreed, except the Grist Mills and the Little Carter.

Gives one guinea to **his grandson Peter Ellis, son of his son Peter**.

Gives to **his son Pascoe Ellis** his two Grist Mills and the Little Carter.

Gives to **his son Thomas Ellis** his leasehold and chattel estate in Great Sellan, of the inheritance of Walter Borlase, Doctor of Law.

Gives to his son **John Ellis** his leasehold and chattel estate in Great Sellan, of the inheritance of Humphry Mackworth Prade, Esq.

Gives 1 guinea to **his kinsman Thomas Ellis**.

Gives 1 shilling each to **his son-in-law Richard Brokenshear and his daughter Eliz: Brokenshear**.

Gives £20 to **his son Francis Ellis**.

Gives £20 to **his son Charles Ellis**.

Appoints **his son Pascoe Ellis** as sole executor of his last will and testament.
