Gives to **his daughter Jane Ellis** an annuity of £30, and if she marries, then his executor to pay her £300.

Gives to **his daughter Ann Ellis** an annuity of £30, and if she marries, then his executor to pay her £300.

Gives to **his daughter Judith Ellis** an annuity of £30, and if she marries, then his executor to pay her £300.

Gives 5 guineas to his wife Ann Ellis.

Gives to his son Peter Curnow Veale Ellis his second-best bed and bedding.

Gives to his daughters Jane, Ann and Judith his third-best bed and bedding.

All the rest of his lands, tenements, goods & chattels, he gives to **his son William Veale Ellis**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.
