Abstract of the Will of Arthur Fox of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 3 May 1748, proved 17 May 1750.

Wills that **his wife Julyan** may live with **her sons Arthur and John** and gives her an annuity of £4 pocket money.

Gives to **his son John** the tenement of Rayll Wotfall and Ventenrais as well as half of his tin---- and his second best horse and an old but reliable plough.

Gives £20 to his daughter Rebecca Trewartha.

Gives 20 shillings to **his daughter Ellizabeth Provis**, she having already secured her marriage portion.

Gives 20 shillings each to his granddaughters Elizabeth, Rebecca, Mary and Christian.

Gives to his grandson John Provis a three-year-old heifer.

Gives 20 shillings to his grandson Henry Provis.

Gives 1 shilling to Wm Trewartha.

Gives 1 shilling to **Henry Provis**.

Gives to **his son Arthur Fox** all the rest of his goods and chattels making him sole executor of his last will and testament.
