Abstract of the Will of Benjamin Fox of the Parish of Illogan in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 3 Aug 1737, proved 8 Nov 1737.

Gives to **John Fox the son of Arthur Fox** the tenement of Raill along with its corn, two oxen, five young bullocks, two cows, one colt, and ten sheep, so long as he pays £5 to **his sister Rebecca Trewartha**, £5 to **his sister Elizabeth Fox**, and £10 to **his brother Arthur Fox**.

Gives 5 shillings to **John Fox the son of John Fox**.

Gives 5 shillings to **An Fox daughter of John Fox**.

Gives 5 shillings to **Christian Fox daughter of John Fox**.

Gives £10 10s. to **his brother Arthur Fox**.

All his goods and chattels not already bequeathed he gives to **Diana Fox** and **Rebecca Fox** whom he makes and ordains joint executrices of his last will and testament.

Gives to **Arthur Fox** and Stephen Tonkin all his goods and chattels in Trust for his executrices during their minority.
