*The Nuncupative Will of Thomas Fox of Illogan, recorded 16 Feb 1648/9, proved 20 Jun 1649.*

In the name of god Amen the xvith day of February *Anno Dni* 1648 Thomas Fox of Illogan in the County of Cornwall being sick in body but of perfect memory declared his will nuncupative in manner & forme following, vizt he gave unto the poore of St Agnes & to the poore of Illogan vi<sup>s</sup>. viij<sup>d</sup> a peece: also unto **his daughter Sidwell** v<sup>s</sup>. and to **Arthur Fox** v<sup>s</sup>. and to all his grandchildren ij<sup>s</sup>. a peece, more to Kathren Wm v<sup>s</sup>. to David Bray j<sup>s</sup>. to his mayde servant j<sup>s</sup>. & to Mary Paule xij<sup>d</sup>. All the rest of his goods and Chattels he gave unto **his eldest Sonn John Fox** whom he made his sole & only Executor here being three & here present John Tonkin & David Bray with

The last will and Testament of me Thomas Fox of Illuggan

Impr: I doe give unto the poore of the Parish of St Agnes by my will — £0 6s 00d

It: I doe give unto the poore of Illuggan — £0 6s 00d

It: I doe give unto **my Daughter Sedwell** — £0 5s 00d

It: I doe give unto **my Sonn Arthur Fox** — £0 5s 00d

It: I doe give unto all my Grand Children 2 shillings to each of them.

It: I doe give to all my god Children . . . . .

It: I doe give unto Catherine William upon my bequest — £0 5s 00d

It: I doe give unto David Bre one shilling if he live in the house . . . . . I die out of his . . . . .

It: I doe give . . . . . to the servant maid that here is now — £0 1s 00d

It: I doe give unto Mary Paule — £0 1s 00d

It: I doe make **my eldest Son John Fox** my whole & sole Executor who will I hope see this my will fulfilled.

It: I doe give to the writer hereof — £0 1s 06d
