Abstract of the Will of Jeffery Gartrell of the Parish of Phillack in the County of Cornwall, Yeoman, written 8 Nov 1648, proved 16 Feb 1655/6.

Gives 1 shilling to his eldest son Jeffery Gartrell.

Gives to his godchildren 12 pence each.

Gives to his three married daughters 12 pence each.

Gives an annuity of 40 shillings to **his wife Elizabeth**; her food, linen and woollen clothing, hosen and shoes, bedding &c. to be paid by his executor. He also gives her eight ewes, one milk cow with calf, to be kept at the tenement of Treglissen wortha. If his wife does not wish to continue living at the house with his executor, then he gives her instead an annuity of £6.

Gives £70 to his daughter Jane.

Gives 6 shillings 8 pence each to the children of Richard Lakes and John Nowell.

Gives a heifer aged two years to Elizabeth the daughter of Richard Lakes.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives to **his son John Gartrell**, appointing him sole executor of his last will and testament.

Nominates his sons-in-law Richard Lakes and John Nowell overseers, giving them 5 shillings each for their pains.
