Gives 1 shilling to **his eldest son Jeffery Gartrell**, he having already received his inheritance.

Gives 20 shillings to his son Richard Gartrell.

Gives 20 shillings to his son William Gartrell.

Gives 20 shillings to his son John Gartrell.

Gives 1 shilling to **his daughter Anna the wife of James White**, she having already received her marriage portion.

Gives 20 shillings to his daughter Katherine Gartrell.

Gives to his granddaughter Katherine, the daughter of his son Jeffery Gartrell, one heifer calf once it has been weaned.

Gives to his granddaughter Jane, the daughter of James White, a heifer aged one year.

Gives to his grandson James, the son of James White, one ewe lamb.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his wife Wilmott**, appointing her sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Gives 5 shillings each to his grandsons Jeffery and John, the sons of his son Richard Gartrell.
