Gives and bequeaths 5 shillings to his sister Mary Gartrell.

Gives and bequeaths 5 shillings each to the four children of **his sister Elizth**. **Richards**.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to his sister Cordelia Vivian.

Gives and bequeaths 5 shillings to his niece Jane Hockin.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to his niece Elizth: Wise.

Gives and bequeaths an annuity of 20 shillings to **Mary Vivian the wife of Henry Vivian** for as long as she may live.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his niece Mary Gartrell** whom he nominates and appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.
