Abstract of the Will of John Glynn, Clerk, written 30 Apr 1730, proved 10 Sep 1731.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **his brother Otho Glynn**.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **his sister Susanna Hearle**.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **his sister Mary Penhallo**.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **his sister Luce Vivian**.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to Elizabeth Tucker, widow of Philip Tucker of Gwinear.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to the poor of the parish of Gwinear.

All the rest of his personal and real estate he gives and bequeaths to **his nephew Thomas Glynn** whom he makes sole executor of his last will and testament.
