

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers, PROB 11/1550/117.

*Abstract of the Will of Thomas Grylls of the Borough of Helston in the County of Cornwall, Esq., written 8 May 1813, proved 7 Dec 1813.*

Referring to his marriage settlement with **Mary his wife** he bequeaths to her an annuity of £200 for life. Gives his wife a further annuity of £150 during her widowhood, effective from the death of **her mother Mrs. Mary Treweeke**.

Gives to **his mother-in-law Mary Treweeke formerly Millett** annuities of £140, £42 and £50 to which she is entitled for her life out of the property formerly belonging to her late husband Humphrey Millett.

Names as beneficiaries of his will **his eldest son Humphrey Millett Grylls, his sons Thomas Grylls, Glynn Grylls, Gerveys Grylls, Charles Grylls and his daughters Cordelia, Emily Meliora, Caroline and Loveday Marshall**.
