Abstract of the Will of Anthony Harry in the Town of Marazion in the County of Cornwall, Mason, written 15 Jan 1755, proved 9 May 1757.

Gives £5 to **his daughter Joan Farrel**.

Gives to **his daughter-in-law Margaret Harry** and her two daughters a shilling each.

Gives to **his son-in-law John Roberts** and his children one shilling each.

Gives to **his son Joseph Harry** the field known as Cracken Codnor, on condition he pays £5 to his executrices.

Gives to **his two daughter Elizabeth Harry and Phillis Hill wife of Nicholas Hill**, shipwright, his dwelling house, orchards, gardens, mowhay, barns, a field called High Gwallan, household goods & furniture, corn, cash, plate, bills and remainder of his goods & chattels, appointing them co-executrices of his last will and testament.

He also gives his executrices his seat in Marazion Chapel.
